

Users and Roles (Setup / System) - Add Permissions To Restrict User and Role Setup Access (21014)

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Two new permissions have been added to provide better control over who can add and edit users, roles, and permissions. These two permissions operate independently:

Permission 488: Add / Edit Users, User Roles, and User Division Access

- Controls access to the *User Setup* screen
- When disabled for a given role, the **Users** option is hidden from *Setup > System* menu options to any user assigned to that role.
- Note: Users can still view and edit their own personal user profile when this is disabled.

Permission 489: Add / Edit Roles and Role Permission Access

- Controls access to the *Role Setup* and *Permission Setup* screens
- When disabled for a given role, the **Roles** option and the **Permissions** option are both hidden from *Setup > System* menu options to any user assigned to that role.



To ensure uninterrupted access, a one-time script was run to automatically grant both new permissions to all existing roles that already had access to Setup / System (Permission 120).

If you wish to **restrict** certain roles from editing users, roles, and permissions, you will need to manually remove these new permissions from those roles.
